



Accessibility Statement

Darlington Gymnastics Club subscribes to the principles of equality of opportunity and aims to ensure that anyone participating or wishing to participate in gymnastics is able to do so in a discrimination free environment.

Venue

DGC is a single storey building with a ramped external and internal entrance way. The whole of the ground floor is accessible to wheelchairs and an adapted toilet is available.

Doors are of acceptable width for wheelchairs / buggies, and staff are available to help on request.

Flooring is non-slip.

Access through to an associated club, where refreshments are available is through double standard doors, which a member of staff will be happy to hold open for you.

Car Parking

There are 2 accessible parking spaces directly outside the front door of DGC. Further car parking is available within 60m of the Club and we are able to reserve a space with enough notice. Drop-off / pick-up directly from the main entrance can also be arranged.

Alternative Information Formats

We will be more than happy to provide information in alternative formats if requested.

Assistance Dogs

Registered guide / assistance dogs are welcome at DGC. When we cannot easily identify that an animal is a service animal, our staff may ask a person to provide documentation (template, letter or form) from a regulated health professional that confirms the person needs the service animal for reasons relating to their disability.

A service animal can be easily identified through visual indicators, such as when it wears a harness or a vest, or when it helps the person perform certain tasks.

Gym Area

The gym area is uneven due to the use of sprung floors matting etc. Where possible these changes are marked with a change in colour to aid those with visual problems
